

T I P S for Using eHealth

Assisting citizens to register using Hong Kong Identity Card (HKID) and give sharing consent

1* What are the benefits of registering for eHealth?
eHealth participation is voluntary and helps establish your lifelong electronic health records.
Healthcare Provider (HCP) must obtain your sharing consent to access your records.

2* Okay, I want to register and give sharing consent.
Participant Information Notice(PIN) Personal Information Collection Statement(PICS)
Please first read the PIN and the PICS by scanning the QR codes.

3* Okay, I've read and understood them.
You can register and give sharing consent using your HKID.
If you agree, please provide your HKID for identity verification.
Understood.

4 Your identity is verified. You can insert your HKID into this eHealth card reader by yourself to agree to register and give sharing consent.
If citizens are physically incapable of inserting the HKID, staff may assist after citizens understand and agree.

5* You have successfully registered and given sharing consent.
You will receive a confirmation notification through your selected communication means.

* Applicable to citizen using other identity documents eligible in eHealth registration and giving sharing consent

Reminder: Please ensure the citizen clearly agrees before proceeding with their registration!

You can also enter citizens' personal information into the eHealth system, print out and have them sign on the eHealth consent form to register for them.
