






Pilot Projects

Public Private Interface – Electronic Patient Record Sharing Pilot (Launched in Apr 2006)

- Participating private healthcare providers (HCP) to view their patients'
 medical records kept at the Hospital Authority (HA) (i.e. "one-way
 viewing")
- Pilot project to test the feasibility and acceptability of eHR sharing
- Enrollment figures as at 1st August 2011:
 - more than 159,000 patients
 - more than 2,293 healthcare professionals
 - All 13 private hospitals
 - More than 290 centres from 43 private or non-government organisations providing healthcare services


























Displaying radiology images from the Private Radiology Facility




Radiological Image Sharing Pilot

- Promote enhanced network connectivity of Private Radiology facilities
- Promote adoption of digital imaging modalities in Private sector Radiology
- Facilitate access of Public sector patients to Private sector Radiology services
