

BACKGROUND

- In Hong Kong, there are currently only three tertiary institutions offering courses related to eHealth knowledge
 - HKU SPACE: Advanced Certificate / Advanced Diploma in Health Informatics
 - Baptist U: MSc IT Management (Health Informatics)
 - Poly U: MSc Health Informatics
- We see the <u>need of having an entry-level series of</u> <u>awareness and hands-on trainings</u> to cater to various needs in the healthcare and IT industries to partly close the gap between their acquired knowledge/skills and the tertiary courses
